

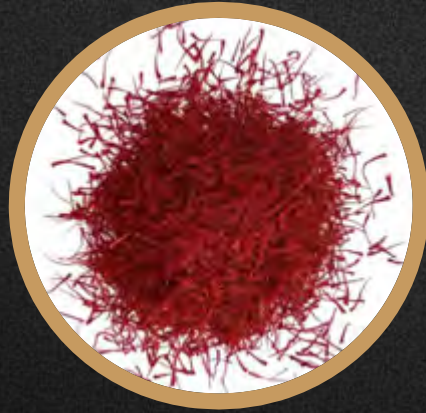

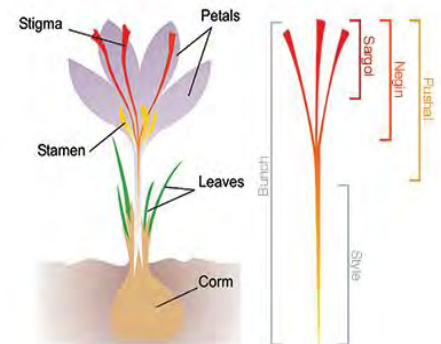

SUPER NEGIN

Super Negin Saffron is recognized as one of the highest-quality saffrons globally. Known for its premium all-red stigmas, it features slightly larger threads than Negin Saffron, offering exceptional aroma and coloring properties



NEGIN

Negin Saffron is also one of the best quality types of saffron that is produced from grade 1 saffron and contains only the red parts of the stigma.



SARGOL

Sargol Saffron consists solely of the red parts of the stigma, featuring shorter threads compared to Negin and Super Negin Saffron. In Sargol, the stigmas are separated from the style, ensuring high coloring power



PUSHAL

Pushal Saffron contains both the red parts of the stigma and a small portion of the yellow style, resulting in slightly lower coloring power compared to Super Negin, Negin, and Sargol Saffron. Despite this, Pushal Saffron is highly valued for its unique flavor and aroma.
